## THIS WEEK'S LESSON: JESUS ANSWERS NICODEMUS' TOUGH QUESTIONS

### LESSON SUMMARY:

Ask your child what they learned about this week:

A religious leader named Nicodemus comes to see Jesus. Most religious leaders don't like Jesus, so Nicodemus sneaks to see him at night. As he talks with Jesus, Nicodemus asks some hard questions. Jesus answers them because **Jesus isn't afraid of hard questions**.

### HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Give everyone a scrap of paper or two. Have each person write one or two fun questions to talk about, such as favorite things, memories, or doing new things for the first time. Put all the paper scraps in a jar or cup. When you're about to drive somewhere as a family, grab a question to discuss on the way! You can also pick out a question to discuss over a meal. Try to discuss all the questions throughout the week. See how questions bring you closer together.

### AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- What's the most important question you'd like to ask God?
- What questions do you have about God?
- What truths do you know for sure?

### AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

*"For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life" (John 3:16).*

### PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

**Jesus isn't afraid of hard questions**. Kids have a lot of questions! Often, the church may feel like an unsafe place for questions. Kids may have gotten the message that asking questions is a sign of a lack of faith. Help kids see that questions are a great way to get to know Jesus better. Questions grow our faith! Pray that kids will be open and honest about their questions, and pray for wisdom in how to help kids find answers.
